of the Council of State accordingly give and grant unto
William Batt two hundred and fiftie acres of
Land beginning at a Cedar point in a small Creek on
the west side of the North river in Morbark Bay and
so running one hundred twentie five poles for breadth
unto a Landing place in the narrow of the river and
from thence three hundred and twentie poles North
North West and from thence West South West one
hundred twentie five poles and from thence South
South East unto the Creek unto the Cedar point where
it began. The said two hundred and fiftie acres of
Land being due unto him the said William Batt by
virtue for the transportation of five persons into the
Colony whose names are in the records mentioned under
this patent. To have and to hold &c To be held &c
yielding and paying unto our Sovereign Lord the
King his heirs and Successors for every fiftie acres
of Land therein by these persons given and granted
yearly at the feast of St Michael the Archangel the
fee rent of one shilling to his Majesty for which payment
is to be made seven years after the date of the for
feiture and not before &c dated the first of September
1643

Joseph Cobb seven hundred acres of Land situate lying
and being in the County of the Isles of Wight in the
County of Warwickshire river bounded Northwesterly
on the back Creek that floweth from the Lands of
John Baster Southwesterly with the woods for breadth
easterly upon the side of the said Creek running Northwesterly
unto the woods for length The said seven hundred acres
of Land being due unto him the said Joseph Cobb by a
former patent bearing date the fourteenth of August
one thousand six hundred thirty seven To him and
to his heirs &c To be held &c yielding and paying unto

of said Sovereign Lord the King his heirs and
 Successors for every fifth acres of land herein
 by these presents given and granted yearly
 at the feast of St Michael the Archangel the
 fee rent of one shilling to his Majesty's use which
 payment is to be made season yearly after the date
 of his former patent of the fourth of August
 one thousand six hundred thirty four and
 not before &c. dated the first of September
 1643

 the Colony whose names are in the records mentioned
 under this patent to him and to hold &c. to be
 held &c. according and paying unto the said
 Lord the King his heirs and Successors for every

 and granted yearly at the feast of St Michael
 the Archangel the fee rent of one shilling to his
 Majesty's use which payment is to be made season yearly
 after the date of these presents and not before &c.
