Carson of the County of Fort Bend Republic of Texas in consideration of the sum of two thousand and one hundred Dollars to me paid by Ammon Underwood of the aforesaid Republic and County of Bogoria the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge do hereby give grant sell and convey unto the said Ammon Underwood his heirs and assigns my entire interest as Cohair in a league of land granted by the Government of Mexico to William Le Garson situated west of the San Bernard River in the County of Matagorda also my entire interest as Cohair in a fourth of a league of land granted to William Hensley by the aforesaid Government of Mexico and conveyed by said Hensley to the aforesaid William Le Garson lying and situated on the East side of the San Bernard River in the County of Fort Bend and also my entire stock of Cattle say three hundred head more or less marked with a crop off the right ear and branded W. Also my entire stock of Horses mules mares & Colts branded as above say twenty five head more or less and also all stock of the above named kinds in any other marks or brands owned by me, together with the natural increase also my waggon and team farming utensils and furniture. Do have and to hold the aforesaid property to the said Ammon Underwood his heirs and assigns to his and their use and behoof forever and I the said John P. Carson do hereby for myself and my heirs Executors and administrators Covenant with the said Ammon Underwood his heirs and assigns that I am lawfully seized in fee simple of the aforesaid property that it is free from all incumbrances, that I have good right to sell and convey the same to the said Ammon Underwood and that I will and my heirs Executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said Ammon Underwood his heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons provided nevertheless that if the said John P. Carson his heirs Executors or administrators pay to the said Ammon Underwood his heirs Executors administrators or assigns the sum of two thousand and one hundred Dollars on or before the first day of January one thousand eight hundred and forty five, that this Deed as also a certain note of hand bearing even date with these presents given by the said John P. Carson to the said Ammon Underwood to pay the same sum at the time aforesaid shall both be void otherwise they shall remain in full force. In witness whereof I the said John P.
