Sudden Denth.

On Tuesday, Sept. 6. 1864, near the residence of Capt. La Fairfield, on the Bluff-ton road two miles from the city, Mrs. Olive

Fairfield, came to a sudden and unexpected death. She was in apparent good health and was walking from a neighbor's, where she had been visiting, to her own home, when she fell dead in the road. A Coroner's jury was called, and a verdict returned of "visitation of Providence." The cause of her death is supposed to have been appoplexy. Her husband, Capt. Fairfield, was absent from home when the death of his wife occurred. Her body is to be buried to-morrow. The age of the decessed was 69 years.
