Oliver Stone of Kennebunkport, Maine where Capt. Clea Fairfield also lived and where your grand-father, James Monroe Fairfield was born in 1826. When Olive Stone was married her father, Sapt. Oliver Stone had full sets of teachoons, table shoons, knives and forks made from sterling silver in Philadelphia, for his daughter, and this is one of the teaspoons. It was

given to me by my uncle Cyrus King Fairfield. He and his first wife aunt anna Fairfield lived with my grandfather and grandmother Fairfield and they unherited the family heirlooms together with my dunt Olive Phillips. She gave away to her friends (so I have been told) the silver teapat, sugar bowl + pitcher to also much of the selver ware when it came into her possession.
